ITEM TITLE	Update Collier Site Council Bylaws
DISCUSSION NOTES	Site Council read over and updated the Site Council Bylaws to meet current Site Council guidelines.

ITEM TITLE	After School Clubs Quarters 2 and 3

ITEM TITLE	New Playground PE Equipment

We would like to use \$500 to purchase new equipment for students to use with their teachers at PE break and at lunch time.

ITEM TITLE	Safety: Radios for Staff

The radios we currently have are not holding charges and are wearing out. We would like to purchase 10 radios at a cost of \$2,450.00 to replace the radios we currently have.

Site Council would like to skip having the Planetarium this year since we have had it two years in a row. We would like to still ask the Desert Museum to come, and will look for one more science based guest speaker to come to share information with students.

ITEM TITLE	Bulletin Boards for 6 th Grade
DISCUSSION NOTES	We added 6 th grade to Collier last school year. This classroom does not have an exterior bulletin board to display student work. We would like \$700 from undesignated funds to purchase a board for the classroom.

ITEM TITLE	Garden Supplies to enhance and revitalize our school garden
DISCUSSION NOTES	Our school garden is in need of updating. This garden will be used by all classrooms based on our school STEAM focus. Each class will be planting seeds and caring for the garden. We need to purchase the supplies (potting soil, seeds, hose, art supplies) to get our garden back in shape for planting and allow classes to create art for the garden. We will use \$2000 in undesignated funds to support this school initiative.

ITEM TITLE	Additional Funds to Support OMA

ITEM TITLE	Field Trips
DISCUSSION NOTES	Kindergarten is asking for funds to go to the Tucson Children's Museum for the Count it Out Program. The cost of the trip is \$9 per student. There are 13 students in the class and one teacher. Additional adults will need to pay their own fee. We will use the bus that was approved for Kindergarten in the March 2025 meeting. Kindergarten, 1 st , and 2 nd Grade would like to go to Sabino Canyon on a field trip. This aligns to their Science and Math standards. The trip is free and we will use the bus we approved for 1 st grade in the March 2025 meeting for this trip.
